Buses

The Leeds free city bus runs every few minutes (06.30 to 19.30 Monday to Saturday) and links Leeds' rail and bus stations with our City Centre campus (stops outside the Rose Bowl on Portland Way). Our main bus stops on Woodhouse Lane are served by numbers 1, 28B, 92, 95, 96, 97 and X84. The 28B and 92 stop on our Headingley Campus with other services stopping at Otley Road/Churchwood Avenue.



Trains

Leeds Station is approximately 10 minutes walk away.



Parking

Pay on foot parking is available at the Rose Bowl and Woodhouse Lane multi-story car park.
